TOWN OF MONROE BOARD OF ETHICS IS REACTIVATED

Monroe, NY, April 4, 2016 – After an absence of several years, the Board of Ethics of the Town of Monroe, NY has been reactivated and is now meeting regularly.

The Board of Ethics is a committee comprised of nine (9) members whose overall responsibility is to implement the Town's Code of Ethics which includes all employees, board members and consultants. It also renders advisory opinions to Town officers and employees and investigates alleged violations by any Town officer, employee or consultant.

Violation Complaint forms can be downloaded from the Town's website, www.monroeny.org, and are available in the Town's Clerk's office and the Monroe Senior Center.

The written complaint must be signed and hand delivered to the Town Clerk in a sealed envelope addressed to the Town of Monroe Board of Ethics.
